The following General Terms and Conditions are an integral part of every contract for the sale of tourist services, holiday packages, hotel accommodation, etc. made by TO.

## 1) Definitions

- 1.1 "TO" refers to Bali Day Tours, a company duly registered in the Republic of Indonesia.
- 1.2 "Participant" refers to the person who has booked and/or is participating in a tour operated by TO.
- 1.3 "Agent" refers to any person who books a tour operated by TO on behalf of a Participant.
- 1.4 "Tour" refers to the arrangement of transport, accommodation, and/or other tourist services, offered by TO.
- 1.5 "Tour price" refers to the price quoted by TO for the tour, which includes the cost of transport, accommodation, and/or other tourist services, as applicable.
- 1.6 "Itinerary" refers to the specific details of a tour, including the sequence of activities, transport, accommodation, and/or other tourist services to be provided.
- 1.7 "Departure date" refers to the date on which the tour is scheduled to commence.
- 1.8 "Package price" refers to the price quoted by TO for the combination of a tour and one or more other tourist services, such as hotel accommodation, domestic airfare, etc.
- 1.9 "Services" refers to the transport, accommodation, and/or other tourist services provided as part of a tour.
- 2) Conditions of sale
- 2.1 The contract for the sale of tourist services between TO and the Participant is concluded when the Participant has received and accepted the TO Itinerary.
- 2.2 The Participant is responsible for reading and understanding the Itinerary.
- 2.3 The Participant is responsible for ensuring that all information in the Itinerary is correct and accurate.
- 2.4 The Participant is responsible for verifying the accuracy of all information related to the tour, including but not limited to the dates, times,
- locations, and prices of services.
- 2.5 The Participant is responsible for familiarizing themselves with the General Terms and Conditions and specific conditions related to the tour, which are set forth in the Itinerary.
